Dear Members and Friends of FiftyNorth,

I am energized by the many ways in which our beloved FiftyNorth is coming back! 2022 was our first full year with no pandemic-related operational disruptions. (Wish we could say the same about the snow!) FiftyNorth is bustling with activity – our classrooms and parking lot are so often full these days. Our total membership grew leaps and bounds from 1,227 to 1,705 in 2022. And, ever-committed to removing barriers to accessing all that FiftyNorth offers, \$48,906 in membership scholarships helped older adults facing financial challenges to join. We have a dedicated team of staff that is always looking for new ways to enrich members' experience at FiftyNorth.

 Michelle Loken, Program Coordinator, joined our team to provide a robust connection to local artists and

- art education opportunities for our members.
- •Deb Olien, Assistant Manager, became part of our Used-a-Bit Shoppe team.
- Kerry Hjelmgren was warmly welcomed as our new Executive Director in mid-September.

Staff has worked diligently to restore and generate expanded programming, and to form community partnerships and create collaborations - especially initiatives that were paused or put on hold due to the COVID-19 pandemic. A new partnership with HealthFinders Collaborative has generated boxing and zumba classes; with St. Olaf College, a balance and falls prevention program; with Cannon Valley Makers, wood-working classes; and with Northfield Hospital and Clinics, wellness classes. FiftyNorth also resumed more fitness classes for residents at the Northfield Retirement Community. And, FiftyNorth's Zoom fitness classes are here to stay to ensure we reach our

members who are at home or traveling. COVID greatly impacted volunteerism at FiftyNorth, as it did all nonprofit organizations like ours. But over the last year, our volunteers have been coming back! FiftyNorth's 160+ volunteers help us live our mission every day at the Center, at the Used-a-Bit Shoppe, and (of course) at FiftyNorth's "signature" Popcorn Wagon on Bridge Square.

With our program, partnership and membership growth, we continue to look for ways to make our current space better meet our needs. Important additions include: the Wellness Center received new treadmills and bike machines; members have enjoyed the new Functional Fitness Room; Personal Training sessions have become increasingly popular; and a rain garden was installed near the entrance to avoid ice build-up on the sidewalks.

In late 2022, the future of our planned expansion shifted from imminent to

unknown. With FiftyNorth membership still growing, and member interests expanding, the Facilities Committee will focus on assessing and improving current Center space to maximize its functionality and usage for our members. As always, we welcome your ideas for improvement! In the coming year, we will be refurbishing the Popcorn Wagon, introducing the first annual Membership Experience Survey for member input, redesigning the FiftyNorth website, increasing the variety and number of fitness classes offered in-person and online, engaging in more community outreach and events, and continuing to serve our members and community with programming and opportunities that enrich the mind, body, and spirit. In these ways, we will embrace and transform our new normal. As we get used to living with COVID, thank you for coming back to FiftyNorth – as a member, volunteer, donor, supporter, or partner.



#### **Projects**
